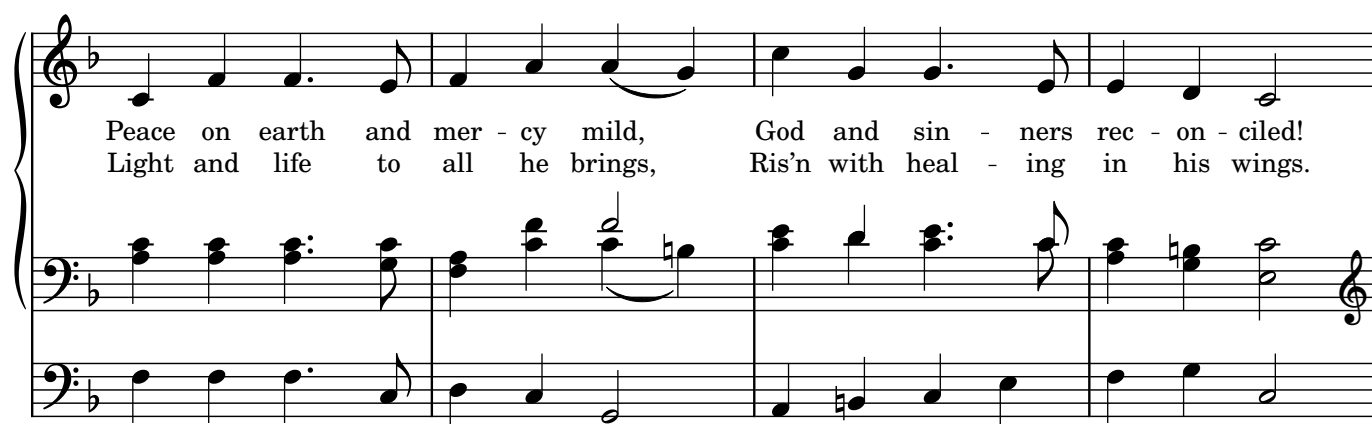


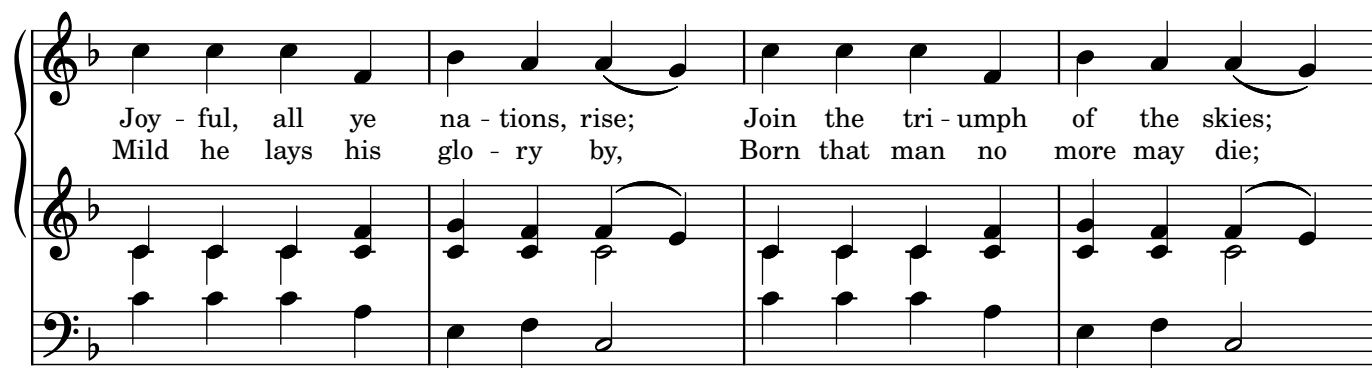

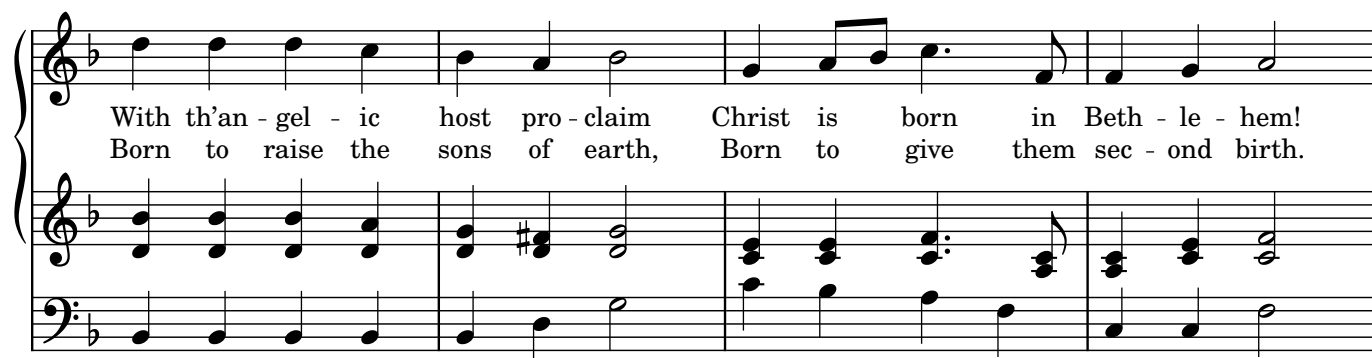

1. Hark! The her - ald an - gels sing Glo - ry to the new - born King!
